WARM UP PROCEDURE

Lanes 2 to 8: General Swimming, feet first entry only
Lane 1: Dive Sprint lane
Backstroke device/s are available for warmup
NO competition warm up/down lanes are reserved
Coaches are to manage their swimmers in the lanes

This series is a new addition to our annual calendar and aims to provide our members more opportunities to compete in a long course environment, whilst also obtaining qualifying times for upcoming events. It also allows current and prospective Regional Athlete Development Squad members the chance to obtain XLR8 points.

The Long Course Carnival will not exceed four hours in length; leading to an action packed afternoon, open to all financially registered club and competitive members of Swimming New Zealand. No awards will be offered, however make sure to brush up on your Swimming Otago knowledge. More information included in the Meet Program, don't miss your chance to win prizes!

Swimming Otago reserves the right to restrict entries to ensure the timeline is adhered to. Swimming Otago will endeavour to obtain the necessary number of technical officials, but the number on pool deck may be more or less, than the requirement set out in Swimming New Zealand approval criteria.

ENTRY DETAILS

1. Entry Fees are \$7.00 per event.
2. Entries close at 8:00pm on Friday 17th January 2020.
3. Restrictions: athletes may enter either the 800m or 1500m Free BUT not both. Dependant on entry numbers these two events maybe raced together.
4. NO late entries will be accepted.
5. NO refunds for withdrawals after close of entries. Submitted medical certificates maybe given refund consideration when received prior to the commencement of the carnival.
6. Athletes aged as at 19th January 2020.
7. Any required invoicing will be based on entries as at 18th January 2020 and will incur a \$10.00 processing fee.
8. No draft psych sheets will be published, Final Psych Sheets will be posted on the Swimming Otago Event Page from 9:30pm on 17th January 2020.
9. All other meet information will be published on our Event Page as it comes to hand.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

This carnival will be swum under SNZ Swimming Rules and Policies with the following specific conditions & criteria:

10. The meet shall be swum long course (50m), with converted short course being accepted and seeded accordingly.
11. All events are mixed gender, timed final using over the top starts.
12. Athletes with a disability may compete at this carnival and shall do so under the IPC rules. PARA athletes must present their classification cards to the meet director prior to the start of the meet.
13. No qualifying times but coaches are asked to ensure their athletes are capable of the distanced entered.
14. Time trials will NOT be permitted.
15. Regional and National Records will not be able to be achieved.

11. Withdrawals and Protest; SNZ Policy 008, Withdraws and Protests, will be applied, click [here](#) to view the full policy.
12. Results will be published as open.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

13. **Carnival Programs;** To be more environmentally responsible programmes will **NOT** be available at this carnival, this includes; Clubs, Team Managers and Coaches. Programs will be available for viewing and printing (if you wish) from 5.00pm Saturday 18th January 2020.
14. **Seating** NO swimmer, manager or coach is to stand and/or sit on the pool deck during the carnival session, use the seating available in the grandstand OR the designated coach's area on the pool deck.
15. **Marshalling** is located at the deep end of the main pool in the grandstand. Swimmers should marshal at least six (6) races prior to theirs.
16. **Disqualification notices** can be uplifted from Club boxes.
17. **Results** will be posted as soon as possible, on the gym window below the grandstand at the shallow end of the main pool. Meet Mobile will be available, and results will be published on our Event Page at the conclusion of the event.
18. **Officials, Timekeepers and Volunteers** indicate your availability via the Duty Sheet, accessible via our Event Page or by clicking [here](#) (note; this is a shared document via Google Doc's therefore the names showing are filled positions).
 - a. Each attending Otago affiliated club **MUST** provide one (1) Technical Official/Timekeeper/Volunteer for every four (4) competitors. When an Otago affiliated club fails to fulfil their obligation, the club will be allocated position/s (where required).
 - b. Pre-Event meeting for Technical Officials will be held 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the carnival, in the back hallway.
 - c. Bring your own water bottle, refills will be possible throughout the carnival.
