



**Relay:**

All four (4) members must be a current financial member of a Swimming Otago affiliated Member Club

The fastest recorded time will be recognised for open male and open female relay teams

Records for each course length shall be for the same distances as set out below with females and males separate

**Ratification Process:**

Record is obtained within the Region OR at a Swimming NZ competition, no application is required to be submitted

Record obtained outside of the Region, an application must be submitted to Swimming Otago within twenty-one (21) days of the performance, or within twenty-one days (21) days of a competitor/team returning from overseas, when the record was obtained outside of the Otago region

Application Form may be sent via email, postal address or hand delivered

Swimming Otago will identify and verify the Record, using supplied documentation and the SNZ Results Database

Once satisfied all rules have been adhered to and those officiating were qualified to do so, Swimming Otago Board will grant approval

**Process:**

Swimming Otago will maintain a register of long-course and short-course individual and relay records

All ratified records will be updated monthly, published on our website and certificates issued
