Purpose:	To ensure a consistence and transparent approach to unattached members within our Region
Policy:	Member Unattached Policy
Process:	<p>Swimmer must be a current financially registered swimmer within the SNZ Database and there is no money owing to their current affiliated club</p> <p>Seek approval from the Swimming Otago Board to become Unattached, include reasons for your submission</p> <p>Once approved, the swimmer will be transferred to Otago Administration (Swimming Otago Associated Member Club) and issued a new Meet Manger ID, starting with UNA, details will be supplied in a formally letter</p> <p>Swimmer will enter competitions, pay annual affiliation fees and maintain their correct information thru their MyPage</p> <p>Swimmer is to regularly view our website and Facebook page to ensure they miss no information</p>
Competition Restrictions:	<p>Unattached members will be able to compete in any Swimming Otago sanctioned competitions throughout the region.</p> <p>Entry criteria for other competitions, held within our Region (South Island Country & Town Competition, South Island Championships and any Swimming New Zealand competitions), must be adhered to.</p> <p>Unattached members will not accumulate points, where given, in any Swimming Otago sanctioned competitions</p> <p>Unattached members will not be eligible for relay team selection, at any level of competition</p>
